3^d Thursday, Partially clear. Mr. Messrs. J. P. & S. worked in a Gulch or Ravine, one mile off, dug \$74.00 1 Lump of \$21.00. I worked all night although weak to get a small Cradle.

We kept our Cabin, quite a rainy day, & for us a dull New Year-
Prep for war with Indians -

4th Friday. S.P. & I collected with both cradles \$42.00 - Clear -

6th A tolerable clear day, Commenced raining at dusk- Mr. Richardson &
