

**PROPOSED DRAFT SCHEDULE FOR PROPOSED
DISPUTE RESOLUTION / MEDIATION REGULATIONS**

(October 21, 2022)

January 20, 2023	Commission reviews and votes on Proposed Draft Regulations, post version on website and seek Tribal / Public Consultation.
January 20-March 31, 2023	Commence 60-day Tribal Consultation with including virtual listening sessions.
April 1-14, 2023	Summarize comments and make related changes.
April 15, 2023	Submit Proposed Draft Regulations to Subcommittee for review.
May 1, 2023	If changes are made to the draft during consultation, then submit updated Proposed Draft Regulations reviewed by Subcommittee for CNRA/AG/GOAR review for legal issues.
July 21, 2023	Proposed Draft Regulations included on Commission Agenda for review and approval. (A special meeting can be called to approve the regulations prior to this regularly scheduled Commission meeting)
July 23, 2023 – September 4, 2023	Submit Proposed Draft Regulations to Department of Finance for fiscal impact assessment. Process takes about 30-days.
September 4, 2023	Submit rulemaking package (Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action [NOPA], proposed regulation, initial statement of reasons and economic and fiscal impact statement to OAL for publication in the Regulatory Notice Register.
November 2023	Publication of the NOPA in the Regulatory Notice Register, initiating the rulemaking process which must be completed in one year (by November 2024).
March 4, 2024 – April 18, 2024	45-day Public Comment Period
March -April 2024	Public hearing(s). At least (1) Public Hearing
April 18 – 30, 2024	Staff summarizes comments and drafts proposed responses.

May 3, 2024	Special Commission meeting held to approve staff responses to comments and either revise or finalize Proposed Draft Regulations.
May 10, 2024	If the Commission does not make substantive changes to Proposed Draft Regulations, the rulemaking record is transferred to OAL which has 30-days to review the Proposed Draft Regulations which take effect on a quarterly basis after OAL approval and submission to the Secretary of State.
May 2024 (If Changes are Made to Regs)	If the Commission makes substantial changes to the Proposed Draft Regulations, then these would need to be published by OAL and a minimum 15-day review period would be required.
June 2024	Public Comment Period on proposed changes to the regulations ends.
June 2024	Staff summarizes comments and drafts proposed responses which the Commission adopts including for final Proposed Draft Regulations.
July 19, 2024	If the Commission does not make substantive changes to Proposed Draft Regulations, the rulemaking record would be transferred to OAL which has 30-days to review the proposed regulations which take effect on a quarterly basis after OAL approval and submission to the Secretary of State.
August 20, 2024	Proposed Draft Regulations become final.
November 2024	Regulatory process must be completed or started a new.
