I am Bernice Paipa, a Tribal Citizen of Iipay Nation of Santa Ysabel. As former Tribal Chairwoman I worked with a 6-member Tribal Council to secure 400 plus acres of traditional homelands of the Iipay Nation of Santa Ysabel. We worked on developing the first Human Resource, Finance, and Tribal Police Departments on the reservations all during the Pandemic of 2020 – 2022. As secretary of the Kumeyaay Cultural Repatriation Committee for the last 25 years, I have worked with the board to repatriate over 30 Kumeyaay Collections that included ancestors and their property under the Native American Graves and Repatriation Act. Today I continue to



consult as Sycuan Cultural Resource Specialist under NAGPRA/Cal NAGPRA to repatriate Kumeyaay Ancestors and their property.
