# 57th Annual California Native American Day Vendor & Exhibitor Registration Forms

California State Capitol - Friday, September 27, 2024

Started in 1939 by Governor Culbert Olson as "Indian Day," this annual event evolved into California Native American Day in 1968 when it was signed in to law by Governor Ronald Reagan and with the support of California's Tribal Leaders. California Native American Day is a time-honored tradition throughout California's Indian Country and is one of the largest annual events at the State Capitol.

The theme for the 57th annual event is: "Recognizing 100 Years of Citizenship and the Fight for the Right to Vote: 1924-2024." Assemblymember James Ramos will serve as the legislative sponsor. The event will be hosted by the California Tribal Chairpersons Association. California State Tribal Liaisons, the California Native American Heritage Commission, and volunteer members of the planning committee will plan and execute the event. Described below are two opportunities for participation in the event.

Informational Exhibitor Booths - Exhibitor booths serve as informational booths to inform the public. Exhibitor booths may include a variety of entities including, but not limited to: tribes, government entities, and non-profit organizations. Selling items is NOT permitted in exhibitor booths. The exhibitor booth cost-sharing amount is \$500. The cost-sharing for exhibitors covers a pop-up tent, one (1) 6' folding table, two (2) chairs, event insurance, and all permits. To register for an exhibitor booth, please complete page 2.

<u>Retail Vendors Booths</u> - Vendor booths may sell arts, crafts, or other items during California Native American Day. The vendor booth cost-sharing amount is \$150. The vendor fee includes the vendor space, one (1) street parking permit, and event insurance. A Seller's Permit, tents, tables, chairs, or any other items must be supplied by each individual vendor. To register for a vendor booth, please complete pages 3-4.

Vendors are responsible for obtaining their own California Seller's Permit. Questions regarding the permit application should be directed to the State of California Department of Tax and Fee Administration at 1.800.400.7115 or their <a href="website">website</a>. No vendor will be allowed to set-up without a valid California Seller's Permit.

This application is the only method to apply for a California Native American Day vendor booth. No other promises or assurances will be honored.

Vendor spaces will be pre-assigned at random for mapping purposes. No requests for specific booth locations will be honored and booth locations may not be moved once assigned except as needed by event staff.

Parking will be blocked off behind all vendor booths but may not be directly behind the assigned booth. Parking will not be held for specific vendors so please plan to arrive at the beginning of set-up window to secure parking near your booth.

The \$150 vendor fee includes the vendor space, one (1) street parking permit, and event insurance. Tents, tables, chairs, or any other items must be supplied by each individual vendor.

If accepted as a vendor for the 57th Annual California Native American Day on September 27, 2024, the undersigned artist agrees to be bound by all above terms and conditions and understands that no contradicting information will be deemed valid.
